The Limited Entry Office will be responsible for managing the application process and the selection of students will be performed by a selection committee. Qualified applicants must:

- Attend a Health Programs Orientation, meet with a Health Programs Advisor, and complete a Limited Entry Workshop (all within 2 years of the application deadline). (https://www.csn.edu/health-programs-advising)
- Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 for all program prerequisites
- Submit three letters of recommendation on the approved form

Applicants will be ranked and selected using a point system through which points will be awarded. Please see attached Selection Criteria sheet.
